Terms and Conditions

- The party consists of 1 hour on our inflatable after this your party will move to either the studio room or sports hall where you have 45 minutes to have food and cake. It is the parents responsibility to advise their guests of this. Nottingham City council reserve the right to charge for party attendees who do not vacate within the allotted time.
- If a parent of a child attending your party decides to leave their child, or leaves the party at any point during the party, please be advised their child becomes the party parent's responsibility until the parent return. We ask that you obtain any contact numbers necessary.
- During your party at Little Treasures you, as the parent/guardian of the party child, and any remaining adults are required to supervise the children during their stay. Nottingham City Council do not supervise the party
- Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your party is due to start as we cannot always allow entry and do not wish to disappoint parents and the party child.
- Please note you will need to bring your own paper plates, crockery and cups, these will not be provided by the leisure centre.
- If you wish to decorate the function room, bluetac must only be used for banners etc (no tape)
- Public pay and play sessions 5-8 years 25 max 8-11 years 25 max and 11-14 years 21 max
- If you are hiring the beast for a private booking we advise that you stick to our recommendations on age range and user numbers paying particular attention to users of unusual size and build, and the possible impact of this on other users.
- If in the unlikely event of any first aid needs during the course of your party please get in touch with reception immediately.

Rules of Play

- When on the inflatable please wear long sleeves and trousers at all times. We do have set ratios for numbers on people on the inflatable at any one time please keep to these for safety reasons
- In the event of an emergency please leave the inflatable by the quickest possible route and immediately inform a member of the Centre staff.
- Before using the inflatable please remove all shoes, jewellery, gum, bags and anything hard or sharp, long hair should be tied back.
- If you normally wear glasses we would suggest that if possible remove them while on the inflatable.
- Please don't somersault or climb the containing walls.
- When using the slide please keep arms folded across chest and go down feet first only. Do not jump onto the slide
- Please no congregating in the tunnel
- Only one on the slide at a time and wait for the person in front to clear the area before sliding.
- Supervision We recommend that a responsible person needs to be stationed at the top and the bottom of the slide at all times and at the Climbing wall. (private bookings)
