



Terms & Conditions

1. Please be advised that your party is for 1 hours and 45 minutes only, you and your party must vacate on time and leave the party room how you found it. It is the parents responsibility to advise their guests of this. Nottingham City council reserve the right to charge for party attendees who do not vacate within the allotted time.
2. If a parent of a child attending your party decides to leave their child, or leaves the party at any point during the party, please be advised their child becomes the party parent's responsibility until the parent return. We ask that you obtain any contact numbers necessary.
3. During your party at Little Treasures you, as the parent/guardian of the party child, and any remaining adults are required to supervise the children during their stay. Nottingham City Council do not supervise the party
4. Please note that socks must be worn by anyone wishing to use the equipment, and face painting is not permitted.
5. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your party is due to start as we cannot always allow entry and do not wish to disappoint parents and the party child.
6. Please note that parties do not include exclusive use of the soft play apart from Exclusive party's which can be booked on a Saturday and Sunday.
7. The maximum number for an exclusive party is 25 and non exclusive party 15.
8. Height and age restrictions apply, it is our recommendation that these are followed.
9. The Little Treasures Rules of Play must be adhered to at all times, which are clearly displayed at the front of the entrance and are explained below.
10. Please do not allow children to run up and down the slide
11. Children up to three years old can play in the toddler area (7 max) and main area 3-10yrs (19 max)
12. Please note you will need to bring your own paper plates, crockery and cups, these will not be provided by the leisure centre
13. If you wish to decorate the function room, bluetac must only be used for banners etc (no tape)

Rules of Play

- No photography or video is allowed without prior permission from the centre management team
- No food, drink or chewing gum is allowed in the play area
- No glassware is allowed in the play area
- Remove shoes before entering the play area, but please wear socks at all times
- Arms and legs should be covered at all times
- Please remove all jewellery, badges and other sharp objects
- Children who are unwell should not use the play area equipment

- Leave all personal items such as money, mobile phones or keys with parents/guardians outside the play area
- Children who wear glasses (or contact lenses) should take extra care
- No liability will be accepted for any losses, damages or theft
